We are pleased to announce that the 2018 Rutgers Governmental Accounting and Auditing Update Conference will be held on Thursday, November 29th, 2018, from 8:15am to 4:30pm, at the Rutgers University Douglass College Center (Trayes Hall B), 100 George Street in New Brunswick. On behalf of Rutgers Business School's Master's Program in Governmental Accounting and the Center for Governmental Accounting Education and Research, we invite you to attend our annual conference.

The purpose of the conference is to bring leaders in public financial management to address the most pressing issues and provide an update on current regulations, accounting pronouncements, auditing issues and other subjects of interest. Participants will learn about current state fiscal matters from the NJ State Treasurer and the Director of NJ Division of Local Government Services, as well as get an update on auditing, accounting and financial management issues, including the latest GASB pronouncements and governmental auditing issues. Presentations by notable speakers from the fields of government accounting, auditing and other financial management areas are featured. Approximately 150 government auditors, accountants and financial professionals attend the conference each year. Prerequisites and advance preparation are not required. The conference offers 8.0 CPE credit hours for CPAs, RMAs and for Municipal and County Finance Officers: 6 CPEs in Accounting and Auditing (Governmental), 1 CPE in Budgeting and 1 CPE in Finance.
