- Students must complete the essay per the instructions on the application and submit with the application.
- Essays will be judged be judged jointly by the Rutgers Business School Summer Camp and Junior Achievement of New Jersey Campership Committee on content and form.
- Applications must have teacher or principal signature for verification of Junior Achievement activities and free and reduced lunch services.
- Application must be signed by the applicant and the applicant's parent or guardian.
