We are pleased to announce that the 2025 Rutgers Governmental Accounting and Auditing Update Conference will be held on **Thursday**, **December 4**, **2025**. This year's conference will be held virtually over Zoom. On behalf of Rutgers Business School's Master's Program in Governmental Accounting and the Center for Governmental Accounting Education and Research, we invite you to attend our annual conference.

This conference aims to bring together leaders in public financial management to address the most pressing financial and public policy issues, and to provide an update on current regulations, accounting pronouncements, auditing issues, and other subjects of interest. Participants will learn about current state fiscal matters from senior government financial leaders and get an update on auditing, accounting, and financial management issues. The conference will also address the latest GASB pronouncements and governmental auditing issues.

Guest speakers include officials from the NJ State Treasurer's Office, the NJ Division of Local Government Services, the NJ State Comptroller's Office, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, Rutgers faculty, and notable professionals from governmental accounting, auditing, and other financial management areas. Prerequisites and advanced preparation are not required. The conference offers 8 CPE credit hours for CPAs and RMAs (Accounting-Govt- 2.0; Auditing Govt: -1.0; Finance- 4.0; IT- 1) and 8 CPEs for Municipal and County Finance Officers (Accounting- 3.0; Financial- 4.0; IT- 1.0).
